Q&A Tip: All About Chart Sections

Q: I created a chart section and hit configure. Why don't I see any graphs?

A: The graph has no data to show, so no graph is displayed. The graph will appear once your columns have been selected.

Q: How do I create a bar graph?

A: Add a chart section to the report, and hit "configure". Choose one of the bar graph options from the dropdown menu at the bottom left. Then choose the column that will act as a label for the graph. Then choose the column that contains the number that you want to display. When selected, a color bar will pop up and you can choose the color that this number will have on the graph. It is important to choose the label first. Additional columns can be chosen as well and are displayed as additional bars with their own color and the label as chosen from the label column.

Q: How do I create a line graph?

A: Add a chart section to the report, and hit configure. Choose a horizontal line graph from the dropdown menu at the bottom left. Then choose the column that will act as a label for the graph. Then choose the column that contains the number that you want to display. When selected, a color bar will pop up and you can choose the color that this number will have on the graph. It is important to choose the label first.

Q: How do I specify the labels of my bar graph?

A: The label is the first column selected for your graph.

Q: I want a bar graph that counts the number of times certain values occur in a column of my table. How do I do it?

A: This can be done by adding some SQL to your query to generate the appropriate count columns. An example of this type of SQL would be:

```
select distinct ParentName as MailboxOU, count(ParentName) as StaleUserCount
into dbo.SA_mvws_Stale_Mailboxes_Output_Count
from dbo.SA_mvws_Stale_Mailboxes_Output
group by ParentName
```

Once the SQL is added, you can add a report that reports on the values contained in the output table (in this case, SA_mvws_Stale_Mailboxes_Output_Count).

Q: How do I create a pie chart?

A: Add a chart section to the report, and hit configure. Choose "Group Pie" from the dropdown menu at the bottom left. Then drag the column that will be used to group your data to the column header group bar. A pie chart will then be displayed that uses that column as both label and a group by clause to count all rows that contain the same label.

Q: Where do the labels for my pie chart come from?

A: They come from the column that is chosen to group by.
