## **Q&A Tip: Starting StealthAUDIT—some answers to general questions about the console.**

**Q:** How do I write a report?

**A:** Expand your job, then expand the “Configure” node. Right-click on “Reports” and select “New Report”

**Q:** Can I create a report without having a query in the job?

**A:** Yes, you can. Creating a job that only creates reports and does nothing else is a useful feature that can be used to separate data collection and data processing from report generation.

**Q:** The underlying data in the database has changed. Do I need to re-run the job to generate the report?

**A:** No, you do not. You can regenerate a report at any time by right-clicking on the report you wish and selecting “Generate Now.”

**Q:** Can I have the reports emailed to someone instead of published somewhere? Can I do both?

**A:** Yes. Reports can be emailed, or published, or both, or neither.

**Q:** I have historical data enabled. How do I get historical data into my report?

**A:** Historical data is contained in the output tables like any other data in StealthAudit. Simply choose the table that contains the data and build your report. It is often advisable when using historical data to create a filter based on timestamp to control how much data you are viewing.
